About the Program:

Travelers Aid Society of Greater New Orleans Coordinated Entry Program assists homeless residents with counseling, transportation, meal vouchers, mail service, job search assistance and temporary housing opportunities.

Homeless Services:

- Counseling/Case Management
- Provisional usage of our Travelers Aid facility as a mailing address
- Provides shelter vouchers, bus tokens and meal coupons, after enrollment
- Job search assistance including providing work uniforms and supplies when applicable
- Assistance with Food Stamp, Medicaid & Social Security applications
- Referrals for long-term mental health assistance and counseling services, as needed
- Referrals to community resources, job fairs, & local employment events

- **Mondays-Thursdays: 7:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.** in person at our offices or over the phone.
- **Fridays: (By Appointment Only) 7:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.**
